I. Economic Updates

Oil markets remain inflated with many analysts expecting prices to remain high in the coming months. Prices at the pump are expected to remain inflated as well with US strategic petroleum reserves at a 40-year low, mitigating the influence government can have on current prices. The US Government is also currently facing a potential shut down as of midnight Saturday September 30th if a deal cannot be reached in Congress. Economic impact would depend on the length of the potential shutdown but could include a further downgrade of the US credit rating which could lead to additional increases in borrower interest rates. In financial markets, all three major indices posted their first gains in five sessions (days) on Monday 9/25 after posting steep declines in the previous week as elevated long term interest rates and signaling from the Fed of another rate increase before the end of 2023 continue to dominate headlines and dilute the present value of future corporate earnings, thus driving stock prices lower.



II. Current Events

The Panama Canal is facing an extended water crisis due to severe drought conditions, leading to ongoing limitations on vessel traffic and draft depth. Despite efforts to implement water conservation measures earlier this year, a backlog of ships and doubled waiting times have caused concern across shipping and logistics industries. The canal, a vital waterway connecting the Atlantic and Pacific oceans, plays a crucial role in global trade, with over 800 vessels crossing it beyond expectations this year. As water levels continue to decline, there are growing concerns about potential record-low levels by April. This situation underscores the importance of building supply chain resiliency and flexibility, encouraging shippers to prioritize freight visibility, assess delay-absorbing capacities, explore alternative options, and align internal processes. AlixPartners suggests key considerations and actionable steps to mitigate disruptions, including monitoring shipments closely, assessing the supply chain's capacity to absorb delays, exploring alternative sailing schedules, establishing internal processes for prioritizing goods, and communicating potential cost exposures. This water crisis highlights the need for a resilient supply chain and the importance of diversifying shipping lanes to adapt to the challenges of global trade effectively.
